Duple Minor longways

- A1 1 – 6 1st Man and 2nd Woman gypsy clockwise once round.
- A2 1 – 6 1st Woman and 2nd Man gypsy anticlockwise once round.
- B 1 – 4 Two changes of rights and lefts, first passing neighbour right shoulders.
- 5 – 8 All turn single right and left.
- 9 – 14 All move round in a circle (no hands) anticlockwise half way into original places.
- 15 – 16 1st couple cast down a place, 2nd couple moving up.

P.S. Note: This dance is the same as The Highlander's Wedding.

The Wedding.

Longways for as many as will.

Note: *The first Strain twice, and the last once over.*

The first Man and second Woman dance round each other to their Places. The first Woman and second Man do the same. Right-hands and Left sides half round, all turn single and dance round into your places, then first Couple cast off.
